It has been 2.5 years since my last Beagle judging appointment & I am sorry to say on this assessment hind movement has deteriorated a lot. Perhaps this was the ring surface as opposed to grass under the paws but in some classes it was difficult to find a girl who had good width behind. It would also seem wide fronts are now more common than pinning in, saying this I was pleased with my overall winners. MPB (13,4) 1 Arden's Madika Spot On. Beautiful flowing lines on this 7^{1/2} month old broken tri girl. She has a pleasing head & expression, with lovely eye, excellent reach of neck into good shoulders, straight front & tight feet. She held her topline correctly, her stern was well set on & her hindquarters were well muscled. She moved freely with good reach & drive but was a little close going away. 2 Kemp's Timamso Sunaina. Raw bay of just 6 months showing a lot of promise. Beautiful head, eye & expression, low set leathers, well cushioned muzzle, super forehand with good bone down to tight feet, excellent topline into well made hindquarters, good depth of chest & well bodied. She still needs to come up a little on leg to balance her out completely, but time is on her side. Moved well with very good foot timing. 3 Havard's Annavah Imagine. PB (12,4) 1 Jones & Jepson's Eardley Merry Berry. 10^{1/2} month old classic tri with a beautiful head & expression from a kind eye. Good reach of neck into correct shoulders, straight front, good bone & feet. She has a rock solid topline, good depth of chest & spring of rib, short strong loin, correct tailset & well muscled hindquarters with good turn of stifle. She is so precise out & back & covers the ground well for her diminutive size. A real pocket rocket she has style & pizzazz. I just loved her, RCC & BPB. Delighted that my co-judge loved her as much as I did & she went on to BPIS. 2 Bradley & Burgess's Dufosee Star Shine. Very unlucky to meet the winner in such fine form. This 10 month old tri girl has a beautiful head & melting expression from her kind dark eye. Good neck & shoulder, straight well boned front into tight feet. Good depth of chest, topline & well muscled hindquarters which she used to advantage. She moved out well. 3 Madika Spot On. JB (10) 1 Craig's Davricard Ballard. Gorgeous head & expression on this pretty girl, she has an excellent forehand, strong bone & good feet. Level topline into well made & muscled hindquarters. She has a good body shape & that little extra length that gave her, her excellent reach of stride. Sound out & back with good footfall. 2 Philpott's Southistle Penny Locket from Charterwood. Open marked girl who is more compact all round than my winner. She has a beautiful dark eye, & well cushioned flews with good depth. Lovely earset, good neck, front & feet. Level topline, well set on stern & her hindquarters were well constructed, she moved out well. 3 Taylor's Deaconfield Innocence. YB (9,4) 1 May's Janfrey Sapphire. Scopey tri girl with a kind eye & expression. Excellent neck & shoulder, straight front & tight feet. She has good depth to body, holds her topline well & her tailset & hindquarters are copybook. She moved soundly with good foot timing. 2 Hunt's Bondlea Dove. Pleasing head from kind eye. Excellent forehand construction, adequate bone & tight feet. Lovely topline, tailset & depth to body,

she had a good spring of rib & was shown in good conditioning. Moved with a good stride & was sound out & back. 3 Scarlet's Rossut Trendy at Michelroy. NB (13,2) 1 Platt's Charbonnel Image. Pretty head & expression from her kind dark eye. Good forehand, straight front & good feet, she has a lovely topline, depth of chest & spring of rib. Well made hindquarters that were muscled correctly. Shown in good fettle she moved soundly out & back with a good stride. 2 Jones & Jepson's Eardley Jay Walking. Very rich t/w markings on this 6 month old baby. She has a lovely head with very expressive dark eye, lovely body shape, good bone & feet. Her hindquarters were well put together & she used her hocks well on the move. She moved very well for her age, a very nice puppy. 3 Madika Spot On. GB (13,2) 1 Bondlea Dove. 2 Davies' Huntshill Star Gazer from Barrvale. Lovely body shape on the move but tending to bunch her topline on the stack. Lovely head & expression, super neck, shoulder, front & feet. Good depth to body & well ribbed back, her hindquarters were well made & muscled & she moved well. 3 Ayres-Cousins' Eardley Clare Voyant at Viracocha. PGB (14,3) 1 Foster & Jones' Stormpasture Juliette. Beautiful body lines on this shapely girl. She has a superb head & expression, low set leathers & dark eye. Reachy neck into good shoulders, straight well boned front & tight feet. Good depth of chest & spring of rib, level topline & well put together quarters, she was shown in gleaming coat & conditioning. I thought her profile movement was superb, but she decided to flick her front in the challenge which cost her higher honours. 2 Deans' Gempeni Flower Girl. Open marked girl with a pleasing head & expression. Good forehand, neat feet, good depth of chest & well ribbed. Her hindquarters were well muscled & she moved with a good stride, not so positive going away as my winner. 3 Caple's Tregoniggie Colour of Magic at Morsefield. LB (13,2) 1 Craig's Davricard Moonlight. Beautifully shaped girl who moved well with reach & drive. Lovely head, eye & expression, good depth of chest & set of leathers. Excellent forehand with straight well boned front & neat feet. Good depth of chest, spring of rib & strong loin, she held her topline both stacked & on the move. Her hindquarters were well muscled & had a good turn of stifle. Shown in excellent fettle she pushed the winners hard, a quality bitch. 2 Lewis' Pondswood Ruby in Fallowfield. Smart tri girl with a pleasing head & expression. Good forehand, excellent depth of chest, spring of rib & level topline into shapely quarters. She was shown in gleaming coat & conditioning & moved well. 3 Bradley & Burgess' Dufosee Northern Star. OB (9,3a) 1 Jackson's Ch. Bayard Forgetmeknot. What can I say about this quality t/w girl that hasn't already been said? She has a beautiful eye & expression, lovely neck into good shoulders, straight front & neat feet. She holds her topline well, has a good depth of chest & is well ribbed back. Her tailset is correct & her quarters were well made & muscled. Her conditioning today was first class & she moved so soundly out & back with good drive. Could not deny her the CC & on the referees decision BIS. 2 Lewis' Fallowfield Grace. Beautiful t/w girl with a melting expression, lovely eye & earset, crested neck into good shoulders & straight front. Good depth of chest, she is well ribbed back to strong loin, tailset is good & her quarters were conditioned correctly. She was giddy to start with but settled well on her individual assessment & she moved with reach & drive, just preferred the width behind of my winner. 3 Anthony's Ospreagle Just Because. VB (13,1a) A lovely class of oldies. 1 Butters & Theobald's Orchidvale Angelica of Breskar. Stunning t/w girl with textbook make & shape. Beautiful head & mischievous eye & expression, super neck, shoulder, front & feet. Level topline, good depth of chest & well muscled quarters for her 11  years. She was so fluid &

sound on the move & thoroughly enjoyed her outing. Was pushed hard by the equally nice boy for BV but her clean lines won through for me & was delighted to award her BVIS in agreement with my co-judge. 2 Deans' IrCh. Barterhound Bouquet for Gempeni. Quality girl with a beautiful head, eye & expression. Super front, good reach of neck, level topline & well made quarters. I have done her well in the past & today she pushed hard but all being equal she was the baby at 8 years old. 3 Arden's Barterhound Rosebud at Madika. Sp Beg B (6,1a) 1 Rossut Trendy at Michelroy. Pretty l/w girl with a kind head & expression. Pleasing forehand, good depth of body & body shape, well made quarters & good conditioning. She moved out well. 2 Webster's Moonjoon Lily of The Valleys for Houndscoast. Smart dark tan girl with a pleasing head & eye, good forehand, body & quarters. Carrying a little too much weight for my liking, she moved out well at one with her talented handler. 3 Webber's Bondlea Libby.
